INTRODUCTION TO THE INITIATIVE

The Kianda School Sports Complex project is a visionary, parent-led initiative that began with a proposal to improve the Hockey Pitch, evolving into a comprehensive plan for a modern sports complex. This development aligns with the Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC) requirements and aims to support students' holistic growth through improved sports and wellness facilities.

A group of Kianda parents volunteered to support the school in planning and fundraising for this project. They set up 3 committees for this purpose: A Steering Committee to set the project's direction; A Technical Team to work with architects and engineers to plan and design; A Fundraising Team to focus on securing the necessary financial support.

The complex will serve multiple purposes like enhancing student wellness, physical education, and CBC-compliant learning experiences.

This project reflects the school community's commitment to excellence and holistic development for every Kianda student.

The CBC curriculum emphasizes physical development, requiring well-equipped facilities to support physical education for all students.

FEATURES OF THE SPORTS COMPLEX

The project includes renovations to existing facilities and new constructions, forming a complete sports complex that will meet diverse needs. The key features include:

Outdoor Facilities

Hockey Pitch and Running Track:

A synthetic turf hockey field and a 200-meter running track will offer a high-quality surface for students and events.

Basketball Court (Indoor and Outdoor): Includes an indoor basketball court for various events, supporting volleyball, gymnastics, and other sports.

Netball and Volleyball Courts: New netball and volleyball courts will be available and the existing ones resurfaced to meet regulation standards.

Tennis Courts: Two existing tennis courts will be resurfaced and will remain accessible supporting individual and team activities.

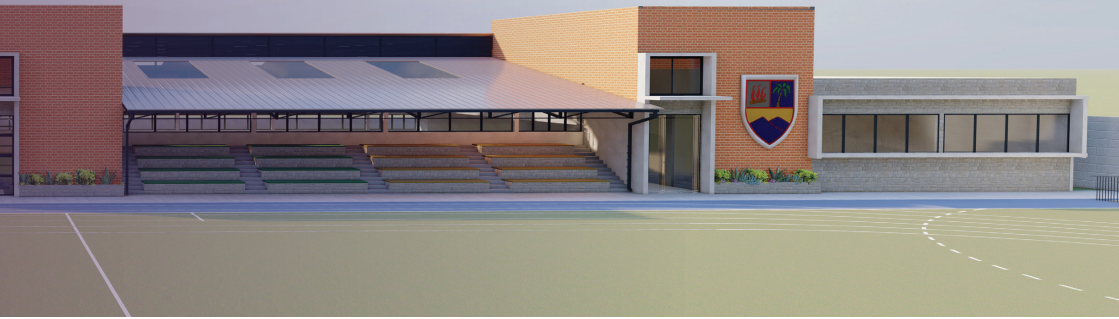
Gymnasium Complex

Indoor Facilities: A multisports gymnasium, including areas for badminton, table tennis, aerobics, and martial arts, with a spectator area.

Changing Rooms and Washrooms: High-capacity changing rooms and washrooms designed to accommodate school and visiting teams.

Spectator Seating and Snack Bar: Covered seating areas for up to 1,300 spectators, with an additional snack bar in the gymnasium.

Inclusive Design and Safety Features: Wide access paths, ramps, and other accessibility features to ensure safe, universal access for all students and visitors.



Green Energy and Safety Features

Solar-Powered Lighting and Water Heating: Solar panels will power the lighting, reducing energy costs and environmental impact.

Rainwater Harvesting and Waste Management: A rainwater collection system and waste management practices will ensure sustainable operation and maintenance.

Boundary Wall and Security: New boundary walls with electric fencing and CCTV monitoring will ensure a safe environment for students and staff.

The Fundraising Committee has developed a multi-faceted approach to meet financial goals.
